- Faith

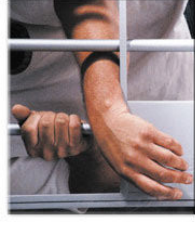

Inmate Correspondence

CLI volunteers serve by encouraging and instructing inmates through letters. Yes, the old fashioned way, writing one inmate at time and addressing his or her specific questions and concerns. We stamp each book and Bible that we send to the prisons; this encourages wonderful letters to us.



Our volunteers have a special heart for this ministry and answer every letter that we receive. That in itself has surprised more than one inmate.

Over 107,000 youth are incarcerated in the US on any given day. They are held in prisons, jails and special youth detention centers.
